Where to stay

Hotel Amphitheatre, 5 rue Diderot - \pm 33 (0) 4 90 96 10 30 We loved it there, we had this attico room with a nice view of the city

- Visit <u>Foundation Van Gogh</u>. The Van Gogh-themed gallery is a mustsee
- And if you're a Van Gogh fan and have seen his painting Café Terrace on the Place du Forum, Arles, at Night, you might want to have a drink at Van Gogh Café, the spot where Van Gogh painted one of his most famous masterpieces.
- Visit Musee de l'Arles antique
- Walk in the old town. There is so much loveliness going around on those narrow streets.
- One of my favorite things in the city was the Roman amphitheatre.
- visit Foundation LUMA ARLES. It is such an innovative project and one
 of Arles' most anticipated new building, a gallery and arts centre, funded
 by the Swiss-based Luma Foundation and designed by the renowned
 architect Frank Gehry.
- dinner at restaurant l'AUTRUCHE, rue Dulau.
- If you happen to be there on a Saturday, don't miss the Saturdaymorning market: local fruits and vegetables, Camargue salt, goats' milk cheese...

And one of the most interesting activities to do: drive to the **Camargue**, **Regional**, **Nature Park**. There are flamingos, horses and pink salinas, say whaaat??;)
